### School Club Travels Road to Success

About halfway through the 1991-92 school year, two science teachers at Belle Vernon Area High School, Belle Vernon, Pennsylvania, discovered that they both had been thinking about getting into the world of Amateur Radio. Tom Thompson, a physics teacher, and Herb Shaffer, a biology instructor, decided it was time to get serious about learning the Novice theory and 5-wpm Morse code. Working on their new endeavor at home and during lunch breaks at school, they both took their first step into the new hobby by passing their Novice test at an exam session at the W3PIE Radio Club in Uniontown, Pennsylvania.

Needless to say, these teachers, now KA3WSQ and KA3WSO, respectively, were fired-up about having a school radio club, and started the ball rolling. They asked the principal at BVA, William Kubin, for permission to start a ham radio club. It was decided that they could give it a try for one year and see what the response would be.

Happily, it went better than imagined. The club managed to get 10 students licensed with Novice privileges during the first year. Obviously, Thompson and Shaffer were thrilled, and the administration was impressed. Soon came more in-

structional materials, antennas, a 2-meter H-T, and—the ultimate—a new Kenwood TS-440 HF rig. Students were operating on the local 2-meter repeaters and also having a blast using the TS-440 on 10 meters to talk to hams all over the place!

As with any team or organization, there are peaks and valleys. Well, about two years into things, the BVA Amateur Radio Club

hit a little slump, but didn't fold. Thankfully, the situation has improved, and this year things are better than ever. The club now has its own call sign, KB3BKW, QSL cards, and a group of intelligent, enthusiastic kids who are really enjoying ham radio.

Shaffer, now a General class operator, and Thompson, an Advanced, both joined the W3PIE Radio Club and belong to the ARRL. *QST* comes in very handy for the weekly meetings, updating all the members on contests and new ideas. One of the club's big activities last year was participating in their first School Club Roundup Contest.

The president of the club this year is Pat Demko, N3TWI, a junior at BVA. Other licensed members of the club include Dean Jackson, N3UPW, who recently passed his Advanced test; Tim Harris, KB3AQE; Gregg Jackson, N3WFX; Scott Hamley, N3WNT; Damon Kuskie, N3WUA; Lisa Lowe, KB3BNN; and Ed Essey, N3WWM. Several other members were preparing for their exams as this article was being written: Shawn Ornot, Tim Miller, Ray Grimes, and Dave Widmer.

The Belle Vernon Area High School ARC is keeping an active schedule. This spring, for example, they operated club station KB3BKW from the famous Kennywood Amusement Park, near Pittsburgh, to commemorate Physics Day (see "Special Events," *QST*, May 1996).

# NETS

The Uniontown ARC holds the Information and Traffic Net on the 147.045 MHz repeater, every Thursday evening at 21:00. Should the 147.045 MHz repeater be inoperative or become inoperative, wait two (2) minutes then tune to the backup repeater, which is 145.170 MHz.

Detailed repeater information such as mode capabilities and offset / PL tone can be found [HERE](#)

In addition, the Keystone-Wide net occurs at 20:00 on Sunday nights, accessible through WIRES-X room 60328. Any System Fusion radio that can reach the Club's 443.750 MHz repeater is your ticket to participate. (We now have that capability on the 147.255 MHz machine, as well). Repeaters and nodes from the western and eastern sections of Pennsylvania are connected to Keystone-Wide. In addition, we have had check-ins from as far away as Australia.

The network is up at all times, so give a call and see who you might be able to chat with - local and not so local. To see the list of repeaters and nodes connected in real time, please visit [Live WiresX Connections \(w3kwh.net\)](#). Special thanks to Christine Rial, N3LRG, for creating this user-friendly resource.

The motivation for Keystone-Wide was to establish a statewide digital voice intercom that allows hams from one area to conveniently meet each other, share ideas, bring clubs together, and generally improve our greater amateur radio community. It can also serve public service efforts such as SKYWARN, when severe weather systems are moving through multi-county areas.

Whenever you are in your shack or just driving around, please tune your System Fusion radio to one of the supporting repeaters or nodes. Throwing out your call or responding to someone else's helps to increase activity and bring more points of presence into this valuable resource.
